Rules & Regulations

- ❖ The Village Farm, its owners, employees, will not be held responsible for any accident, illness or injury (including death), loss, or damage occurring at show.
- ❖ All entry forms are to be completely filled out, signed and submitted with full payment the night before the show by 5pm. Post entries will be accepted at a late fee of \$10. No scratch fees.
- ❖ Entrants may FLAT in the show ring prior to show and between divisions.
- ❖ All dogs must be leashed.
- ❖ All entries/horses on grounds must pay \$10 office fee.
- ❖ \$50 fee for all non-negotiable checks.
- ❖ All ties will remain tied. TVF's decisions are final.
- ❖ Eight ribbons awarded for each class. Champion & Reserve ribbon for each division. Rider/horse combinations that place in all three classes of division receive 5 points toward the division championship.
- ❖ To be eligible for Circuit Awards, you need only place in any of the home shows at the Village Farm.
- ❖ All five 2020 shows count toward the 2019 Circuit Awards, the August show is double points. 10 extra points to riders that compete in all 5 shows.
- ❖ Ribbons to 10th place for Circuit Awards at the banquet on Nov. 28th. All winners must be present or send a representative in order to receive the award.

JO - (Jump Off) After the first round, if the rider is clear w/o faults, they will move into the second round which is timed. Rider must wait for signal to start.

TIME - The first round is timed. Clear rounds will be pinned above those with time faults, knockdowns or refusals.

To be eligible for Circuit Awards you must compete and place at one of the above horse shows. Awards will be given to the competitors that gain the most accumulative points from the TVF show circuit during the show year based on a standard point system. It is designed to recognize the top riders and horses being exhibited at the farm. Separate awards will be available for each division offered. The following rules will apply:

- Division points will be accumulate for each horse/rider combination.
- Exhibitors (riders) will receive a bonus 10 points if they compete in all 5 horse shows.
- All exhibitors must place in at least 1 of the events of that circuit.
- All points accumulated at each show will count toward these special awards.

SHOW ATTIRE Coats are not required. Breeches of a light color, shirts must have collars (no sleeveless shirts or hoods) and must be tucked into breeches. Boots are required. Half chaps are permitted as long as color matches the paddock boot. In extreme weather conditions the use of jackets, sweaters or raincoats without hoods are allowed. Western attire is welcome in Extreme Trail class.
